



DATA CONVERGENCE FOR GOLF COURSES

See who plays. See who spends. See one golfer.

The platform that merges your tee sheet and your food and beverage into one view of every golfer — without replacing a thing.

THE PROBLEM

Your best golfer looks like two strangers.

You run two great systems that have never spoken to each other. So the member who plays twice a week *and* closes down the clubhouse on Fridays shows up as two different people, in two different dashboards.

Tee times, memberships, pro-shop sales, guest bookings.

Your grill and pro shop see

Food & beverage tabs, bar, on-course orders.

Neither system knows they're the same person.

WHAT IT COSTS YOU

You can't grow what you can't see.

01

Your VIPs are invisible

You rank customers by rounds played — not by what they actually spend across golf, food, and retail.

02

F&B revenue walks out

You can't see which regulars never stop for food or a drink, so you can't bring them in.

03

Spend goes anonymous

On-course and food-and-beverage tabs aren't tied to a golfer, so a big chunk of revenue can't be attributed to anyone.

04

Month-end is manual

Two exports, stitched by hand, every single month — and still no single source of truth.

SEE

See every customer whole.

Convergence puts one profile behind every golfer — green fees, food, retail, even league and tournament rounds from GolfGenius. Rank customers by what they actually spend, not by rounds played, and ask anything about them in plain English.

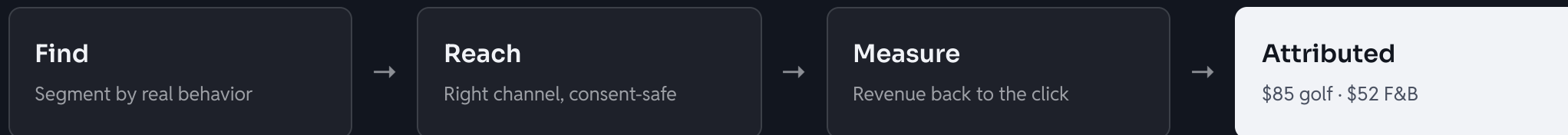
See who plays. See who spends. Connected in an afternoon — nothing to rip out.

Rolling out

Turn outreach into revenue.

Find the golfers worth an offer — the regular who never buys lunch, the member who's gone quiet — reach them on the right channel, then see exactly what it earned: revenue attributed back to the outreach, split golf vs F&B, down to the link they clicked.

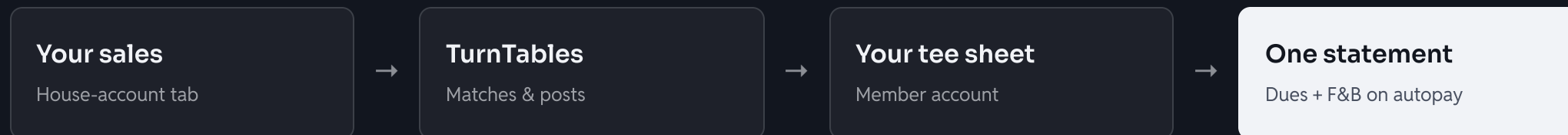


Targeted marketing that closes the loop.

Be ready for every member.

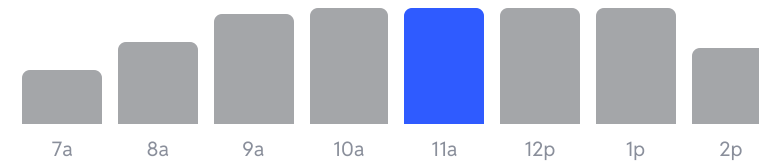
Today's Briefing reads the tee sheet, models pace group by group, and pairs it with each member's history — so you know who's coming, when the rush hits, and what they'll order. The same pace model nudges members to order ahead right before they reach the turn.

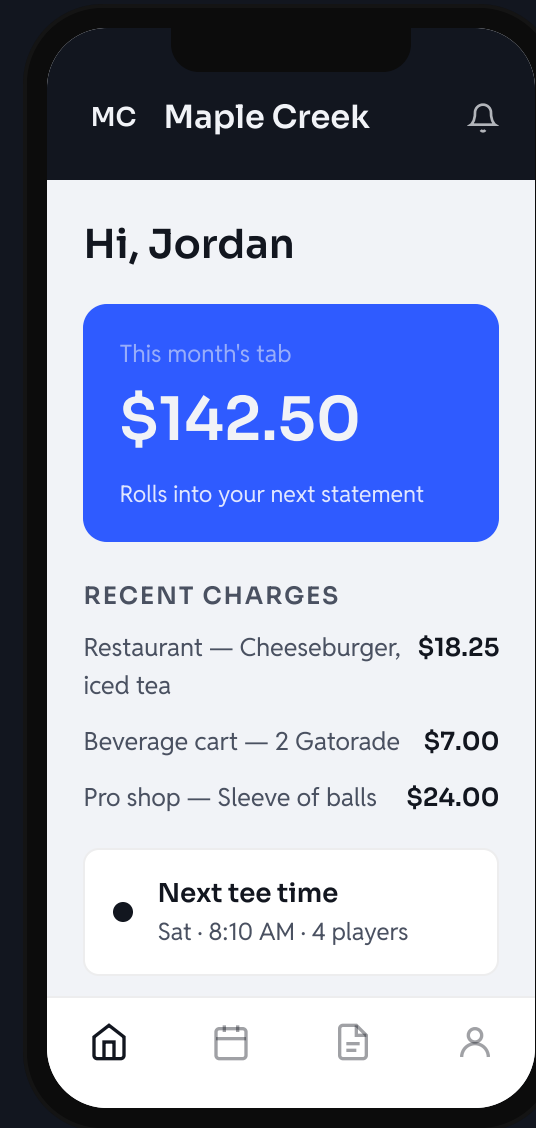
